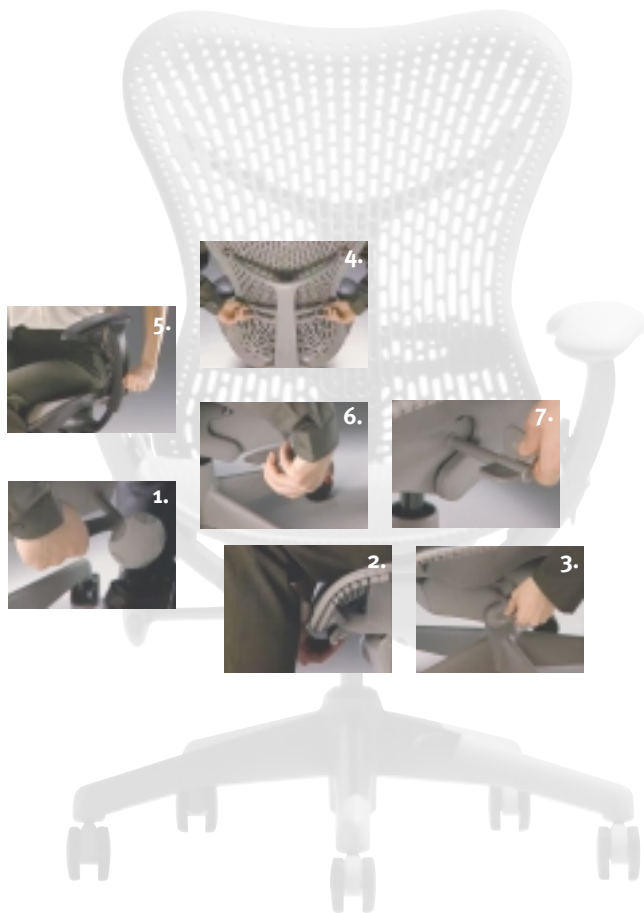

In a world of same-old work chairs, Mirra is a breath of fresh air. With its natural performance, flexible fit, and inventive look, Mirra delivers superior performance for any office task. Its passive ergonomic features automatically adjust to a person's size, posture, and movement. A few active controls fine-tune the fit and feel. Check out the innovations: the responsive TriFlex™ backrest and AireWeave™ seat-suspension material, FlexFront™ adjustable seat depth, Harmonic™ tilt, and more. They all work together in a fresh-looking, practical, and competitively priced chair that's uncommonly easy to use.





#### ADJUSTING THE MIRRA CHAIR

Active adjustments give people control over their own comfort and support.

1. Seat height – Mirra’s pneumatic lift accommodates a spectrum of users. The 16-20½-inch range is for average and larger sizes; the 15-19½-inch range fits smaller people.
2. Seat depth – The FlexFront edge adjusts the front edge of the seat in a 2-inch range. Unlike sliding seat pans, there’s never a gap between the seat and back.
3. Forward seat angle – For intensive work postures, the seat angle can adjust 4 degrees forward.
4. Lumbar support – This mechanism adjusts independent of the back, providing a 4-inch vertical adjustment and a 1-inch depth adjustment.
5. Armrest height, width, and angle – Each armrest adjusts in a 4-inch height range and 1½-inch width range. Armrests pivot 11 degrees inward for key-boarding and 11 degrees outward for mousing.
6. Tilt tension – This adjustment lets you control the resistance felt when you lean back. The control is side-mounted so it’s easy to reach, and it takes just nine revolutions to adjust it from minimum to maximum tension.
7. Tilt limiter – The five-position limiter lets you control how far the chair reclines without locking the tilt mechanism.

#### TOTAL BACK SUPPORT, AUTOMATICALLY

Mirra’s one-piece, TriFlex backrest is pliable and elastic to support the sitter’s entire back. Its geometric shapes and spine construction create flex zones in the upper, lumbar, and sacral areas to conform to anyone’s size, posture, and movements. No manual adjustment is needed. Plus, the camber contour at the base of the backrest forms a passive PostureFit™ that helps the pelvis maintain a forward tilt for proper spinal alignment. The backrest also lets air through so sitters keep their cool.

#### A BALANCED RIDE, NATURALLY

With Mirra’s Harmonic tilt, pivot points are at the user’s hip, knee, and ankle for easy, natural motion. The backrest and seat move in proper relation for the correct support in all seated positions. Advanced spring technology lets the user feel equal support while moving anywhere in the wide, 26-degree tilt range. The sitter is always balanced and in control.

Mirra's breathable AireWeave seat-suspension material conforms to each sitter's shape and size and distributes pressure evenly.

### AESTHETIC APPEAL

The molded polymer back comes in 8 colors, the suspension seat in 10, and the base and frame in 2. Colors can be mixed or matched to fit the interior and image.
